

Please read our information carefully (including details described on our website) to help you decide what shares are right for you. Fill out the form and mail to the farm with your payment. Make sure to keep a copy for yourself. We will send you a confirmation email the week of receiving your signup. Look for a more detailed confirmation letter with directions to your pick-up location in early May. Please list all of the emails that need to receive CSA information, including our pickup reminders and newsletter information about your share. If your e-mail changes during the season, please send us the update as we use e-mail as our primary way to get information to you. You need to let us know if you are not receiving emails from the farm. We will not share your address with anyone.

Elmwood Stock Farm's CSA program is a direct relationship between you and the farm. Weekly mid-May through early-October, boxes of seasonal produce are harvested at the height of ripeness and made available at convenient pickup locations in your area. A season-extending option is offered into November and December that includes seasonal greens and root vegetables, along with winter squash and storage items. Egg shares and meat shares can be added to your basic vegetable share.

Our CSA members get the first pick of the bounty ready for harvest each week, however because of the inherent risks of farming, we cannot guarantee what the season will bring and what vegetables will be harvested. Having grown vegetables at Elmwood for nearly 20 years and being experienced in food production, we have always succeeded in growing an excellent variety of vegetables. You share the risk with us as sometimes you will receive more or less than you expected of certain items, but we will do everything we can to raise successful crops. Items in your produce share will change weekly as reflected by seasonality and what can be successfully grown in KY. Elmwood Stock Farm grows predominantly vegetables, not fruit, though your shares will include berries. Your share will contain produce grown by us, not sourced from other locations, so you will know who is producing your family's food and how it is grown.

**BASIC SHARE OPTIONS – Sign up by April 1<sup>st</sup> to get the discounted price.**

**Mini Share** is designed to feed single adults or couples who eat out often. It is a good introduction to a CSA program, while allowing you to continue shopping your farmers market for more of your desired produce needs. This smallest size will contain a variety each week, but is intended to never overwhelm your refrigerator. Instead of 3 pounds of tomatoes, you get 1½ pounds; instead of 5 squash, you'll get 2. The mini will not have the diversity or amount of any one item that a Regular share contains. It does offer the same great benefits as larger shares including the weekly descriptive newsletter, annual farm tour, and shares delivered to convenient neighborhood pickup locations. **Price through April 1, 2012: \$375, after April 1: \$395.**

**Regular Share** is designed to feed 2 adults or a small household most of their weekly vegetable needs (please look on our website for specific examples of regular shares at various times throughout the season). **Price through April 1, 2012: \$555, after April 1: \$585.**

**Robust Share** is designed to feed a larger family or strictly vegetarian couple most of their weekly vegetable needs. This contains the same diversity of vegetables as a regular share but in larger amounts each week and is the best economical value. **Price through April 1, 2012: \$780, after April 1: \$820.**

**Add to your basic share:**

**Egg Share: 1 dozen or ½ dozen each week.**

These are eggs from free-range chickens living outdoors on organic pasture, enjoying fresh air, sunshine, green grass, & wholesome organic grains. We have a **limited** number of egg shares; only offered as an add-on to your vegetable share.

**Price for 1 dozen weekly: \$132 half-dozen weekly: \$66; after April 1: \$140 dozen, \$70 half-dozen.**

**Meat Share Every-other-week CHICKEN only, total of 11 weeks (more details on meats on product page of website)**

Every-other-week you will receive one whole organic chicken or packages of cut-up pieces – farm choice based on availability. Early season, your share comes from the freezer as chickens are only raised during warm summer months. Later, your chicken share will be from the current growing season. All hens are from our livestock raised on our organic pastures.

**Price for chicken share (one whole chicken or packages of chicken pieces) every-other-week: \$200; after April 1: \$215.**

**Meat Share Every-other-week BEEF only, total of 11 weeks (more details on meats on product page of website)**

Every-other-week you will receive ground meat or beef roast from our certified organic Angus cattle. (Steaks and special cuts not available through CSA). All meat is from our own livestock raised on our organic pastures. Your share will be farm choice based on availability. **Price for beef share (either 2.5-3 pounds ground meat or 1 roast) every-other-week: \$220; after April 1: \$235.**

**Meat Share Weekly: Weekly EITHER chicken or beef, 22 weeks (more details on meats on product page of website)**

Each week you will receive either organic chicken or beef from our certified organic Angus cattle. Your share will be farm choice based on availability and will alternate beef one week, chicken the next, etc. **Price for meat share weekly (either 2.5-3 pounds ground meat or 1 roast OR 1 whole chicken or packages of chicken pieces): \$420; after April 1: \$450.**

**Fall/Winter Share: 5 vegetable distributions over 2 months – only offered as a Regular Size Share.** Seasonal items include lettuces, heavy greens, cabbages, potatoes, winter squashes, root crops & more. **Price for Fall Vegetable share: \$275, eggs with fall vegs: \$60 for 10 doz / \$30 for 5 doz, meat with fall vegs: \$125.**

**Pickup Options:**

- We will try to secure your first choice in pickup location. If your choice is full, we will contact you about details of other available locations.
- At one site, you will meet us at our truck. At most others, we deliver to a protected area (porch, garage, inside a business, etc.) There will be a list at your delivery site for you to sign in and check off your name each week when picking up your shares.
- Shares are packed in reusable, returnable boxes that need to be returned each week. Alternatively, bring your own bags to transfer your share items.
- Shares will still be harvested and distributed even if your pickup day falls on a holiday such as Memorial Day, 4<sup>th</sup> of July, Labor Day.
- Please know that pickup locations and days of the week for the Fall/Winter season may change as porches and garages are not suitable for winter weather food distribution. The Liquor Barn and Lexington Seafood locations will continue as pickup locations for the Fall/Winter season.
